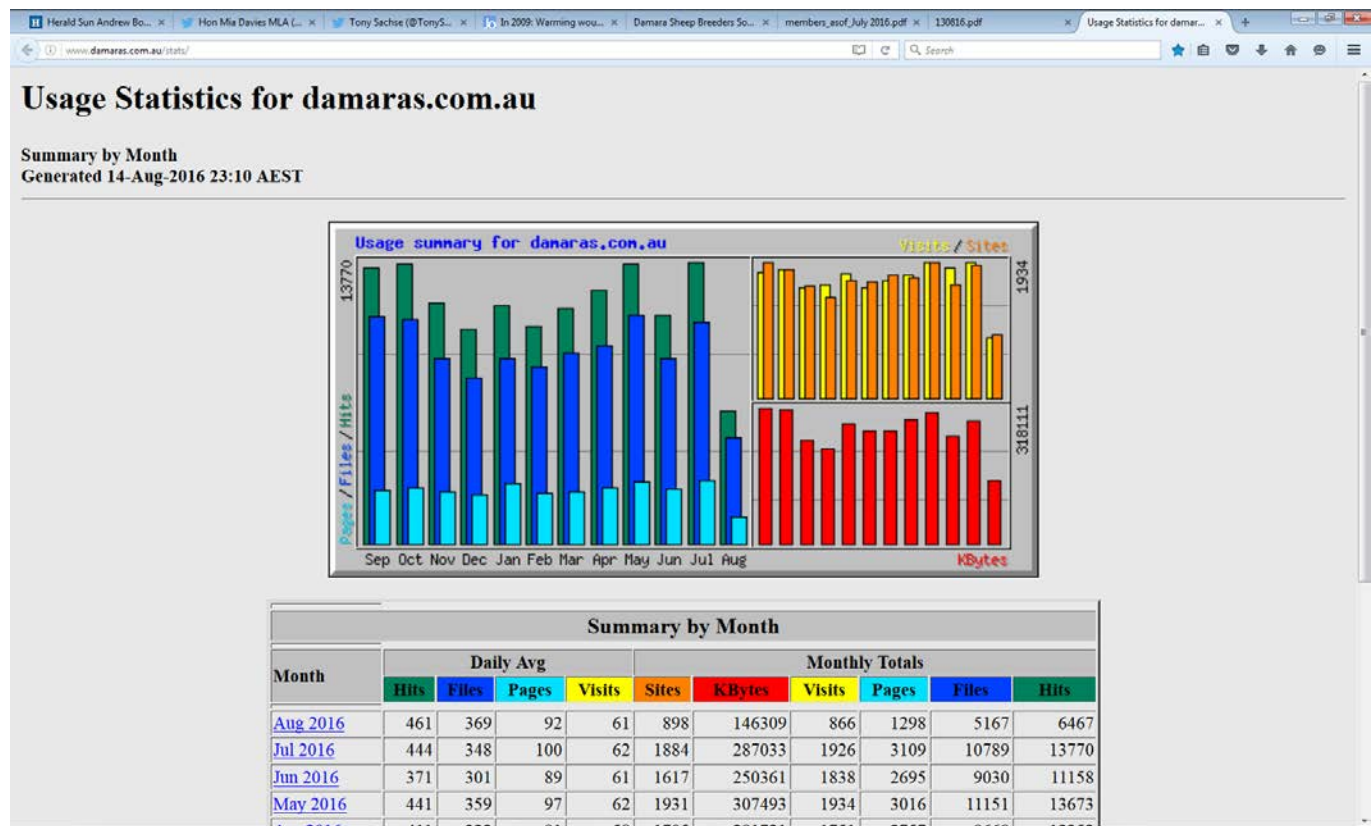
It appears that Viv and Judy Forbes are the longest continuous members with the flock number 0014. Well done Viv and Judy.
